

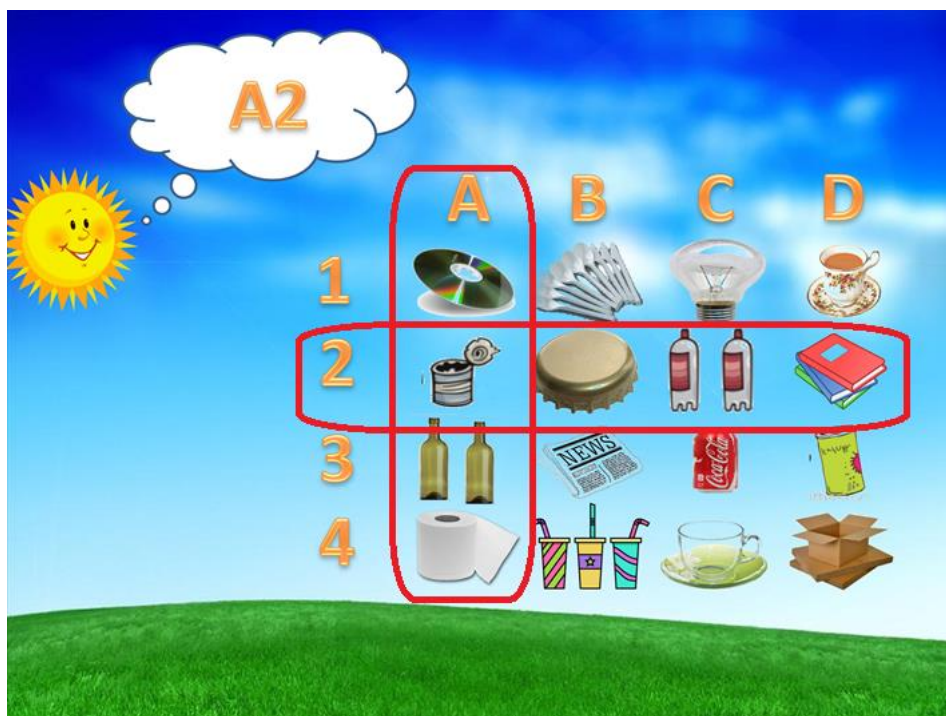

Station 3 – Cleaning up and separating trash

Task: Clean up the beach and help the planet breathe!

Instructions: Play the [game](#) separating the waste and throwing it in the appropriate bin for recycling. You will see different objects which people used and left on the beach. Each object has a code. To identify the object you have to use the horizontal (A-B-C-D) and vertical (1-2-3-4) coordinates.

Example: The object with code A2 is a used can.



After you have identified the object using the code, you have to put it in the correct bin. On the next slide you will see 3 bins:

- the **GREEN** bin is for GLASS;
- the **BLUE** bin is for PAPER, and CARDBOARD BOXES;
- the **YELLOW** bin is for PALSTIC and METAL.

You have to click on bin in which you will put the object. A2 is a can, so, it goes to the **YELLOW** bin, because it is made of metal.

If you have chosen the correct bin, the object will go in it. If you have chosen the wrong bin, don't worry, the trash will go into the correct bin. Next time you will know better where to put your trash so that it is recycled.

You will help the planet breathe!
